1 On Judging

Kath Shillam, a famous Queensland sculptor and one of the founders of our Society in 1969 wrote:

"When the winner is named, inevitably there will be controversy and if you think another piece is better ART then for you it is! Object, Post object, non object, object visible or invisible, according to your mental attitude, it is fun to argue the pros and cons of all this-----but the really successful sculpture of any type, is so completely mind expanding and so totally gut stirring, that when confronted with it, there is nothing left to argue about."

"CONTROVERSY, lets have lots of it."

2 Certificate of Authenticity

Over time I have had people who have purchased sculptures asking me if I could provide information in regard to sculptures they have purchased. On someoccasions I have been able to find information for them and in others I have not been able to assist.

Without a certificate of authenticity, it is impossible to evaluate the work according to its provenance or to attach it to an artist. Its only value depends on its size, technique, materials used and the subject represented.

A certificate is of benefit to both buyers and sculptors alike.

Buyers:

- 1. Establishes the identity of the work, originand authenticity
- 2. Secure value when reselling

Sculptors:

- 3. Ensures the identity and authenticity of the work
- 4. Valuing your buyers
- 5. Adds credibility
