Committee is doing ....	<p>Wharf timbers have been selected. Renovations are being done to the Shed which will house the indoor sculptures.</p> <p>We have secured sponsorship from several Precinct Business Partners. This will help with advertising, printing and having strong plaques built for outdoor works. We are working with EDQ Marketing to design invitations, banners, etc. and these should be completed before the end of the year.</p> <p>The design for the concrete plinths is nearly done - one 250mm high x 900mm square, the other 600mm high x 750mm square at the base. The two sizes will have bolt holes with which to attach outdoor sculptures. This will elevate and present outdoor sculptures in a very stable, secure and professional manner. A diagram of the plinths will be sent soon, to show the position of the bolt holes.</p> <p>* <b>Please email or text by Weds 18<sup>th</sup> December, if you think you <u>might</u> require one of these plinths. We need to know how many might be needed, so we can provide an estimate of costs to Northshore. 	<p>manage the risks that their sculpture poses on installation day and throughout the length of the Exhibition.</p> <p><b>It does not matter that sculptures might not be completed by 23<sup>rd</sup> January, but we need that information</b>, so we can select the works, prepare for and manage the expectation of our partners at Northshore.</p>
Members to do ..	<p><b>ONLY 6 WEEKS TO SUBMISSION DATE 23 January</b></p> <p>Does anyone have completed sculptures and would like their work to be considered for inclusion in our many forms of publicity? Please email high resolution photos and a completed artist statement about the relationship between their piece and the history of the area.</p> <p>All previous Updates and information about the Northshore Exhibition are being loaded onto the website. Check past copies there if you need to.</p> <p><b>IMPORTANT DATES</b></p> <p><b>By date 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2020, Complete the attached Form for all sculptures and follow the required steps as outlined.</b> This is a requirement in selecting pieces for the Exhibition with representatives from Northshore.</p> <p><b>By 30<sup>th</sup> January</b>, we will confirm by email, those sculptures that have been selected.</p> <p><b>By 5<sup>th</sup> February 2020, all completed Entry Forms</b> are to be sent to <a href="mailto:exhibitions@sculptorsqld.org.au">exhibitions@sculptorsqld.org.au</a> and the entry fee paid.</p> <p>Annual Membership is due and payable before 28<sup>th</sup> February for all members. Those wishing to exhibit will need to pay by entry date of the Exhibition.</p> <p>Read Entry Form in detail, especially Important Dates &amp; Conditions of Entry.
