<p>Important Dates</p>	<p>By 23rd January, complete the attached Submission Form (there is no need to complete Entry Form yet), and email to exhibitions@sculptorsqld.org.au indicating both indoor and outdoor sculptures you intend to create before March. Drawings or images of your work is just fine at this time as well as the usual information on size and media.</p> <p>What is important though is to provide a brief description of your work and your artistic interpretation of its connection with the river. For any outdoor works, you must also include installation methods and requirements as per the Submission Form, with attention to managing risks.</p>
	<p>By 30th January you will receive confirmation of your submission’ success. We might ask for more details around the risks perceived in your outdoor piece.</p>
	<p>By 5th February, complete entry forms and email to: exhibitions@sculptorsqld.org.au along with the entry fees and insurance details</p>
	<p>Two concrete plinth sizes will be offered for free - one 250mm high x 900mm square, the other 600mm high x 750mm square at the base. The two sizes will have bolt holes so outdoor sculptures can be bolted to the plinth. This will elevate and present outdoor sculptures in a very stable, secure and professional manner. A diagram of the plinths will be sent soon, to show the position of the bolt holes.</p> <p>Please email or text by 23rd January, if you think you <u>might</u> require one of these plinths. We need to know how many might be needed, so we can provide an estimate of costs to Northshore. This is necessary for budgeting purposes.</p> <p>Does anyone have a current White Card for Workplace Health & Safety?</p> <p>Please email ASAP exhibitions@sculptorsqld.org.au if you hold one.</p>
